I just wanted to write a quick note to all our members about volunteering at WCRA shows. Volunteers, for each show, are critical in helping the show committees run their show smoothly, making it successful and, well, without volunteers we could not put on these shows.

If you are able to volunteer your time, in any way, please contact your local chapter of WCRA and let them know you would be available. Each chapter of WCRA puts on one WCRA high point series show each year at various times through the summer. There are various positions that each show requires volunteers for ranging from scribes, whipper-in, bit checker, office runners, and other miscellaneous jobs. Some of these positions require some experience – but most can easily be shown to someone who has never done them before; and not all of these jobs require you to commit your entire weekend, a few hours a day can help out the show a lot. Even if you plan to show, there may be jobs that you could lend a hand with when you're not riding.
