GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All reining classes will be judged according to the 2010 WCRA rulebook except where designated as NRHA classes, which will be judged according to the 2010 NRHA rulebook. Wherever possible WCRA follows NRHA rules. The WCRA rulebook is available at www.wcra.info or by contacting the Show Secretary.
2. TRR show committee will select patterns. The patterns will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to the start of the competition. Patterns are also available at www.wcra.info or www.nrha.com
3. Payouts are according to NRHA rules. Show will retain 50% of entry fees. Any payouts in WCRA classes will be made in accordance to NRHA rules.
4. All Champions and Reserve Champions must report to the photographer for sponsor photos immediately following the class.
5. Inhumane treatment of horses will be grounds for disqualification, as will abusive treatment of officials and other competitors.
6. All protests and complaints must be made in writing to the show committee.
7. TRR reserves the right to cancel, postpone or re-schedule this event without notice at any time prior to the contest and without liability to TRR or WCRA. Entry fees will be returned in the case of cancellation.
8. Circle Creek Ranch requires all competitors and visitors to clean up after themselves and their animals. Please do not leave garbage on the show grounds or camping area.
9. Camping is available for a fee of \$10 per night. **NOTE – No sewer hook-up or power hook-up.**
10. **Dogs are permitted on a leash only, however it is recommended that dogs stay at home. Please clean up after your dogs.**
11. Youth competitors are encouraged to wear a safety approved helmet whenever possible.
12. Website posting is for information purposes only and is considered "draft only". In the case of a difference between the website and the show office, the show office information will be final.

EQUIPMENT

1. After each work, bits will be dropped and viewed by the judge or designate.
2. In classes where running martingales are permitted, rein stoppers must be used.
3. Equipment must be used as stated in the WCRA rulebook, unless otherwise specified. WCRA rulebook is available online at www.wcra.info

SHOW OFFICE & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Open to all breeds of horses and caliber of riders.
2. It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of their earnings and their horses earnings and enter classes accordingly. Eligibility criteria are explained in the class list provided in the show package and are as of January 1st of the current year. Entrants will be required to sign a declaration of eligibility.
3. Riders and horses owners **MUST PROVIDE** a copy of current HCBC membership. Copies of relevant membership cards and licenses **MUST** be included with entry forms for classes entered.
4. Show fees are waived for riders & owners who are current WCRA members. Non-members have the option of membership or paying a show fee.
5. All riders and owners entered in the show are eligible to enter in WCRA classes. For inclusion in High Point calculations, riders and owners must be WCRA and HCBC members.
6. All fees are made payable to Thompson River Reiners in Canadian funds only. It is the owners responsibility to make the payments on or before the entry due date of May 19th, 2010. TRR will not be responsible for entries or payments received late. Entries postmarked after the entry due date will be

subject to a late entry fee of \$20.00 per class. Any cheques returned due to insufficient funds will be subject to a \$50.00 NSF fee and the late entry fees will apply if cashable funds are not received on or before the entry due date. No post dated cheques will be accepted.

7. Draws will be made May 31, 2010 from all paid entries received by that date.
8. Post entries in all classes will be accepted up to 2 hours before the class, with payment of an additional \$20.00 fee per class, and will be added to the end of the order of go. The show secretary will determine when 2 hours has arrived. Their decision is final in this regard.
9. There will be no refunds, but substitutions of horses will be allowed with a vet certificate or riders with a doctor's note. A \$20.00 substitution fee will apply.
10. Owners may enter more than one horse. A horse may be entered only once per class. Riders may enter up to three horses per class.
11. Both the competition arena and warm up arena will remain open when not otherwise in use. See the show package for specific open riding times. The show committee reserves the right to close the arena for maintenance at any time they deem necessary.
12. Stalls will be available no earlier than Thursday, June 3rd at 4:00pm and must be vacant no later than 12:00 midnight on Sunday, June 6th. NOTE: For competitors traveling a long distance you must contact the show manager if you require stabling early on Thursday or need to stay over Sunday night.
13. All horses on the grounds, whether stalled or not, must be entered in a minimum of one class at the show.
**Note: Stalls must be booked with entries. Additional stalls may not be available for post entries. Please check for availability with the show secretary. No stall fees will be refunded unless the show can re-assign the stalls.*

CLASS CONDITIONS

14. **TRR Never Won a Buckle Non Pro** – Open to riders who meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the NRHA rulebook who have never won a buckle in any reining competition prior to this show. Two handed optional, no running martingale, NRHA legal headgear. Modified pattern. Does not follow NRHA non pro ownership rules.
15. **TRR H20 Non Pro** – Open to riders who meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the NRHA rulebook and who have no earnings as of January 1, 2010, and who have never won a buckle in any reining competition prior to this show. Two handed optional, No running martingale, NRHA legal headgear. Modified pattern. Does not follow NRHA non pro ownership rules.
16. **TRR Freestyle Open** – As per NRHA freestyle rules for required maneuvers – no lead changes required.
17. **TRR 4/5/6 year old Open Derby** – NRHA aged event rules
18. **TRR 4/5/6 year old Non Pro Derby** – NRHA aged event rules
19. **NRHA / WCRA classes** – See current NRHA / WCRA rulebooks for class conditions

their directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, officials, volunteers, business operators and site property owners, (all of them collectively called the HOST).

I am aware and understand that there are Inherent DANGERS, HAZARDS AND RISKS, (collectively called RISKS) associated with Equine Activities. I Acknowledge that these Inherent "RISKS" of Equine Activities mean those DANGEROUS conditions which are an integral part of Equine Activities, including but not limited to:

1. The propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity;
2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
3. The equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects;
4. Collisions with other equines, animals, people and objects;
5. The potential of any participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.

I understand that injuries resulting from such "RISKS" are a common and ordinary occurrence associated with Equine Activities. I freely accept and fully assume all the "RISKS" and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss from being a Participant. I acknowledge that it remains my sole responsibility to act in such a manner as to be responsible for my own safety and to Participate within my own limits. In consideration of the "HOST" Boarding my "HORSE(S) or permitting my Participation in the "ACTIVITY", I together with my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, (Collectively called my "Legal Representatives") agree:

1. To **WAIVE ALL CLAIMS** that I may have against the "Host" and
2. To **RELEASE THE "HOST" FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY** for any loss, damages, injury,, or expense that I or my "Legal Representatives" may suffer as a result of my horse(s) being Boarded or my Participation in the "ACTIVITY" due to any cause whatsoever **INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE "HOST"** and,
3. **TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE "HOST"** from any and all liability for any injury to the HORSE(S) or any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my "HORSE(S) being boarded or my Participation in the "ACTIVITY" and,
4. To maintain in effect a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 third party liability insurance on the HORSE(S) while boarded.

I have read and understand the Rules of the Boarding facility and the "Activity" which apply to me. I agree to abide by those Rules and Acknowledge that a breach of the Rules may among other things, result in my expulsion from the Boarding facility or the "ACTIVITY". Before I signed this Release and Acknowledgment, I read it and I state that I understand it. I am aware that by signing this Release and Acknowledgment, I am waiving certain legal rights which I might have against the "HOST", or, if I die, by signing this Release and Acknowledgments, I am waiving certain rights that my Legal Representatives may have against the "HOST".

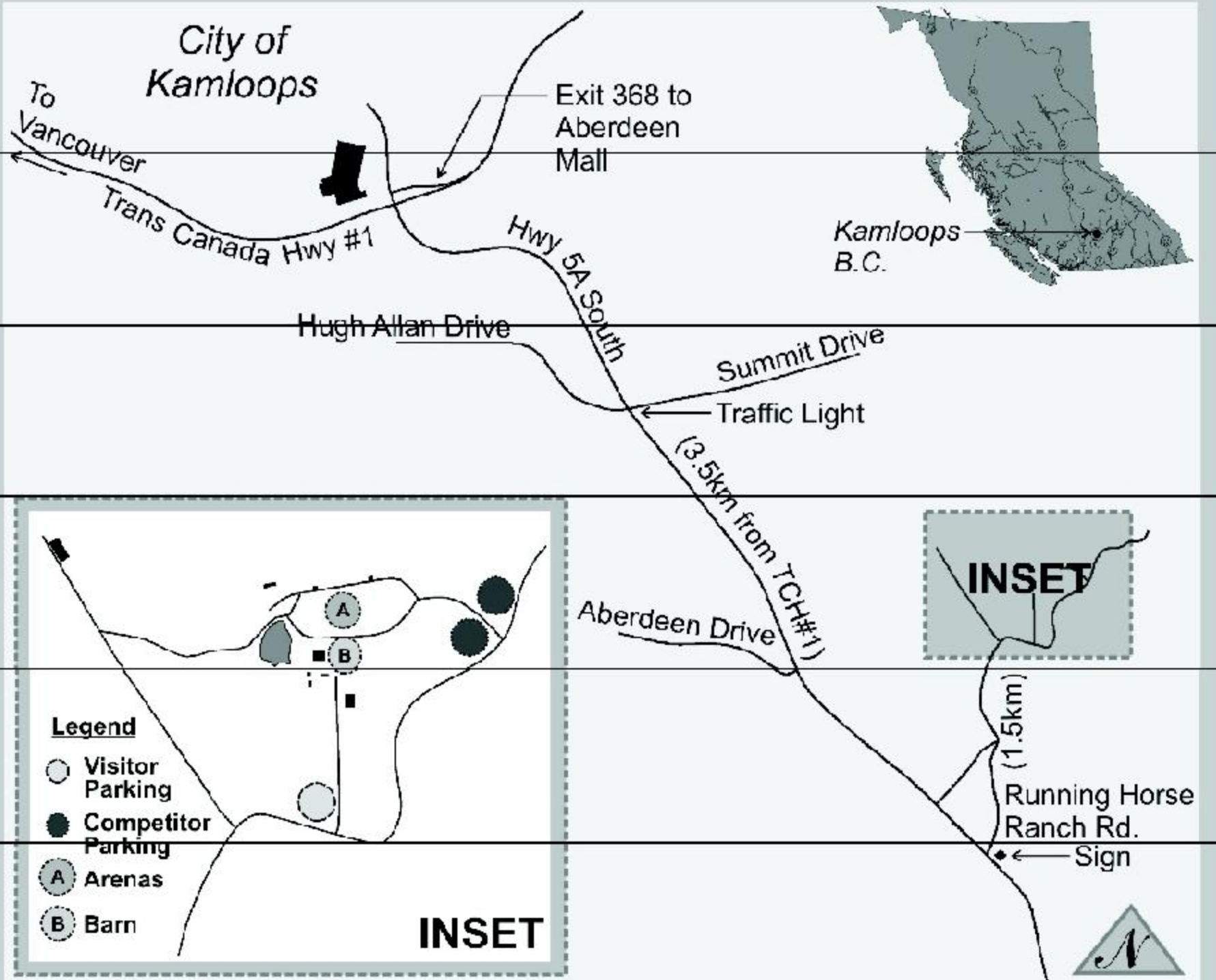
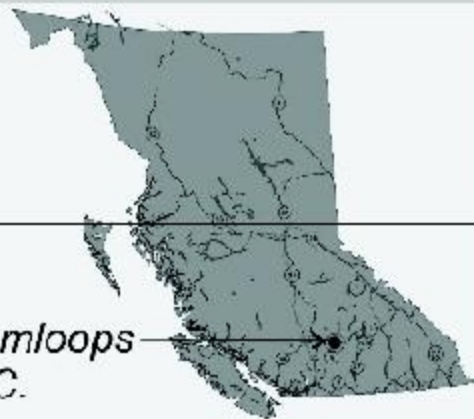
