

*The reining horse knows no equal in the western performance field. The Reining class shows his proficiency in changing leads, spins, stopping and backing. The reining division is one of the most exacting and beautiful of all the performance events in which specific patterns are performed by competitors.*

*The reining horse is quiet, supple and obedient, responding to almost imperceptible cues while performing intricate tasks. Reining builds on solid basics of good horsemanship to develop a communication between horse and rider that creates an art form that is pleasing to watch and especially exciting to perform.*

*To rein a horse is not only to guide him, but also to control his every movement. The best reined horse should be willingly guided or controlled with little or no apparent resistance and dictated to completely. Any movement on his own must be considered a lack of control.*

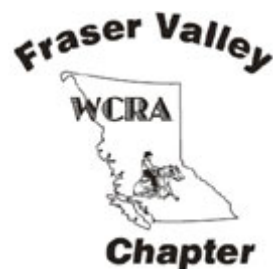
