- **Concurrent Classes** - Classes with the same number run concurrently. If entering both please pay only one (1) Judge's Fee and one (1) WCRA High Point Fee. Please call the Show Secretary with any questions regarding 12a and 20a.
- POST ENTRIES will not be accepted for WORKING COW HORSE classes.
- POST ENTRIES will be accepted until one hour prior to class entering.
- Paid warm-ups will be called by Horse name.
- Participants will be called only once for a coin toss in the event of a tie.

Entrance Requirements

1. Open to all breeds of horses and caliber of riders.
2. Both owners and riders must be either WCRA members or pay a \$35.00 show fee.
3. In NRHA approved classes rider & owner must be NRHA members and horse must have an NRHA competition license in the name of the current owner.
4. Riders and horse owners must provide current HCBC membership numbers or proof of liability insurance at time of registration.
5. Entrants to Non-Pro / Novice / Beginners will be asked to sign a declaration of eligibility and/or produce their NRHA/RC Non-Pro Cards if applicable.
6. No Post Dated Cheques will be accepted. A charge of **\$50.00** will be levied on all NSF Cheques.
7. At all High Point approved shows there will be no entry refunds, but substitutions of horses will be allowed with a vet certificate or riders with a doctor's note.
8. A rider may enter more than one (1) horse in a class, but a horse may not be ridden more than once in a class.
9. Post Entries will be accepted up to one (1) hour before the class, and added to the top of the class list, and will also be charged a **\$25.00 late fee for each class.**
10. All protests and complaints should be taken, in writing, to the Show Secretary for review and decision by the *Rock Slide* Show Committee.
11. It is the responsibility of the owner and rider to be aware of his/her official earnings. Riders may be required to sign a declaration of earnings

General Rules & Conditions

1. All Reining classes will be judged according to National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) 2008 Rule Book, with the exception of Modified Patterns, Beginner NRHA patterns, which will be judged according to WCRA rules. Where ever possible WCRA follows NRHA Rules. If conflict arises between WCRA/NRHA Rules – WCRA Rules will prevail.
2. WCRA's Beginner A; Beginner B and Beginner NRHA Pattern – See 2008 WCRA Hi-Point Rule Book.
2006 WCRA Rule Changes for Reining Classes
 - ❖ Rule Changes affecting Beginner "A" & "B" class eligibility.
 - ❖ Effective 2006 those riders in Beginner A & Beginner B are eligible to ride in all modified classes, including Beginner NRHA Pattern, subject to current WCRA rules for the classes but are unable to cross enter in full pattern, one-handed only classes. Once entered in a full pattern, one handed only class, riders are ineligible to compete in any further Beginner A & Beginner B classes.
 - ❖ Riders competing in full pattern, one-handed only classes, are eligible to compete in Beginner NRHA Pattern classes and Beginner Rider Open and Beginner Horse Open subject to current WCRA. rules.
 - ❖ Once a Championship or Reserve Championship has been earned in either Beginner Horse Open or Beginner Rider Open further competition in Beginner A or B is prohibited.
3. **OWNERSHIP**
 - Beginner A; Beginner B & Beginner NRHA Pattern all follow NRHA "Non Pro" rules which means the horse "must be solely and completely owned by one of the following: (a) the Non Pro, (b) a member or members of his/her immediate family, or (c) a corporation, partnership, or other business entity provided that the Non Pro and/or a member or members of his/her immediate family are the sole and only owners of that business entity and the ownership of that business entity does not change to include non immediate family members or entities" [Non Pro conditions from NRHA 2008 rulebook]
 - Beginner Reiner Open & Beginner Horse Open: Ownership of horse is not a concern as these follow the "Open" rules. For the Beginner Reiner Open the limiting factor is rider's earnings and the Beginner Horse Open it is the horse's earnings.
 - Rookie: This is a Non Pro class but riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership in this class.
4. **WCRA Non Pro Freestyle** - required maneuvers:
 - Minimum of one large circle & one small circle in each direction
 - Minimum of 3 spins in each direction.
 - Minimum of 2 Rollbacks – 1 each direction.
 - Minimum of 1 stop and back up.
 - 3 minute time limit, including any introduction. The time limit will be from the beginning of the music or from the beginning of the introduction (whichever is first) and will end with the music.
 - Open to any Non Pro rider.

- Two handed optional.
 - Running Martingale optional.
5. Inhumane treatment of horses / livestock will be grounds for disqualification, as will abusive treatment of officials and fellow competitors.
 6. *Rock Slide* Show Committee will select patterns. The patterns will be posted at least 1 hour prior to the competition. Patterns are available at <http://wcra-reining.tripod.com/>
 7. Show Committee will retain up to 50% of entry fees prior to payout. All payouts will be mailed to the winners. Payouts will be made in the horse owners name as per the NRHA payout schedule.
 8. All ties for 1st place will be worked off if the tied exhibitors agree to participate in a run-off. Tied exhibitors have the alternative option of agreeing not to run-off and to be named co-champions but must determine the winner of the awards by a flip of a coin. If they do not agree, the exhibitor(s) who does not want to run-off will forfeit first place to the other(s). Following ties will be decided by a coin toss.
 9. **Prizes awarded in all classes.** All 1st through 3rd place winners must report directly to the photographer for sponsor and/or P.R. photos after presentation of awards
 10. The *Rock Slide* Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, change, transfer or reschedule the show without notice and/or liability. In the event of cancellation, all entry fees will be returned
 11. Equipment must be used as stated in the WCRA Rule Book, unless otherwise specified. After each work, bits will be dropped and viewed by the judge or designate. In applicable classes, rein stoppers must be used with running martingales.

CLASS CONDITIONS & ELIGIBILITY FOR WCRA CLASSES:

1. **Beginner A: Beginner B:** May be ridden one- or 2-handed; running martingale optional, must be outfitted with rein stoppers; NRHA legal headgear; modified pattern with no lead changes.
Restricted to riders who:
 - meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book,
 - have never placed 1st, prior to the current year, in a class that required a non-modified NRHA pattern (NRHA patterns 1 thru 10) to be ridden one-handed,
 - have not won a High Point Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner A, Beginner B, Beginner NRHA Pattern, Beginner Horse Open or Beginner Reiner Open.
 - Have not ridden in a full pattern, one-handed only, class.
2. **Beginner NRHA Pattern:** May be ridden 2 handed if a snaffle bit is used; must be ridden one-handed if a curb bit is used, regardless of the horse's age. No running martingale. NRHA legal headgear.
Restricted to riders who:
 - meet the Non Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA Rule Book,
 - have never placed 1st, prior to the current year, in a class that required a non-modified NRHA pattern (NRHA patterns 1 thru 10) to be ridden one-handed,
 - have not won a High Point Championship or Reserve Championship in Beginner NRHA Pattern.
3. **Beginner Horse Open:** May be ridden one- or 2-handed; any NRHA approved headgear; no running martingale.
 - Restricted to horses with less than \$500 lifetime earnings in reining competitions at the start of the year.
4. **Beginner Reiner Open:** Modified pattern with no lead changes; may be ridden one- or 2-handed; any NRHA approved headgear; no running martingale.
 - Restricted to horses with less than \$500 lifetime earnings in reining competitions at the start of the year.

WCRA HIGH POINT SERIES

All riders at WCRA High Point Shows, unless they choose a show fee rather than membership, accumulate points towards year-end High Point prizes. All points are horse/rider specific. There are 14 classes in this program. Shows might offer these High Point classes as either NRHA approved or non NRHA approved. Either one would be eligible for High Point calculations. 2008 High Point Shows include: Peninsula "*Rock Slide*"; WCRA "*West Coast Classic*" and FVRC "*Slide Out West*". A horse/rider combination must enter and compete in a minimum of 2 WCRA High Point Shows in the current year to qualify for a High Point Award.

2008 WCRA-NRHA Affiliate Series: 2008 ADEQUAN NORTH AMERICAN AFFILIATE CHAMPIONSHIPS & NRHA AFFILIATE CIRCUIT SERIES

Peninsula "*Rock Slide*", WCRA "*West Coast Slide*", WCRA "*West Coast Classic*". Riders can enter these NRHA classes without Reining Canada membership but if you also want to be included in the WCRA-NRHA Affiliate Series and have your points tracked by NRHA to qualify to represent WCRA at the Regional Finals in Manitoba you must have your Reining Canada membership in addition to your NRHA membership.

Riders must also fill out, and submit to NRHA prior to July 1, 2008, an NRHA Affiliate Declaration form showing WCRA as your main affiliate.
